WATER BAPTISM

Thus says the Lord: "Stand in the ways and see, and ask for the old paths, where the good way is, and walk in it; Then you will find rest for your souls. But they said, 'We will not walk in it.'"

Jeremiah 6:16

Baptism is a sign of the New Covenant, an initiation rite, and obedience will open heaven over your life (Matthew 3:13-17). Water baptism seals the deal.

1) Baptized in the Red Sea/Your enemies are destroyed in the water

1 Corinthians 10:1-2, Exodus 14:10-18, 26-31

- Matthew 19:26 But Jesus looked at them and said to them, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."
- John 8:36 Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.

2) Three things baptism symbolizes

- 1. The washing away of your sins Acts 22:16 And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.
- 2. Raised to new life in Christ 2 Corinthians 5:17, Romans 6:4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- 3. A prophetic statement that you will also rise from the dead John 5:24-30, 1 Corinthians 6:14 And God both raised up the Lord and will also raise us up by His power.

3) Philip and the Ethiopian - Acts 8:26-40

- The Ethiopian was baptized immediately after believing in Jesus as his personal savior. He was not ashamed to make a public declaration of his new faith.
- Romans 1:16-17 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."
