
THIRST

Introduction: God wants to satiate the parched soul. Refreshing's are coming from the presence of the Lord. If you are thirsty, you shall be filled. If you are dissatisfied with life and thirst for more; you can come to the well that never runs dry.

1) A call to all that are thirsty

John 7:36-38, 14:15-18, 26, Matthew 5:6

- A continual source of satisfaction – Isaiah 55:1-2
- God is doing a new thing and making rivers in the desert – Isaiah 43:18-21
- Demons inhabit dry and arid places – Matthew 12:43-45

2) Life giving water is a symbol of the Holy Spirit

Isaiah 44:3, Acts 2:17-18

- Without water there can be no life. 2/3rds of the earth's surface is water. 2/3rds of the human body is made up of water. Water is a symbol of the Holy Spirit in three ways:
- Water gives life – *For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and do not return there, But water the earth, And make it bring forth and bud, That it may give seed to the sower And bread to the eater. Isaiah 55:10*
- Water cleanses – *Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean; Put away the evil of your doings from before My eyes. Cease to do evil. Isaiah 1:16*
- Water reflects – *As in water face reflects face, so a man's heart reveals the man. Proverbs 27:19*

3. You must come humbly and thirsty to be refreshed

- *Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, Acts 3:19*
- *If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9*
