Our hope in God is an anchor to our soul in an unstable world

Hebrews 6:18-19 - That by two immutable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we might have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of the hope set before us. This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters the Presence behind the veil.

1. Everything is being shaken

- Hebrews 12:25-29 Although there is instability in the world, we have an unshakable kingdom
- There can be instability in governments, economies, churches and our personal lives but when we build our households on Christ we can whether any storm Matthew 7:24-27
- Isaiah 33:6 Wisdom and knowledge will be the stability of your times, and the strength of salvation; the fear of the LORD is His treasure.

2. Five unshakable things

- 1. Unshakable person, Jesus Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
- 2. Unshakable promises, the Word 2 Corinthians 1:20, *Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.*
- 3. Unshakable power, the Holy Spirit Acts 1:8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.
- 4. Unshakable provision Philippians 4:19, *Ephesians 3:20-21 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us.*
- 5. Unshakable proclamation, the Gospel John 3:16-21

- Biblical hope is confidence in God Romans 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
