MARK 5

Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes." Mark 9:23

- 1) Jesus demonstrates his power over nature Mark 4:35-41
- **2)** Jesus demonstrates his power over demons and heals the mind and soul–vs.1-20 Isaiah 53:5b "The chastisement of our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed."
- 3) Jesus demonstrates his power over incurable disease vs.21-34
 - It's hard to imagine 12 years of suffering sickness and segregation, (Leviticus 15:25-30)
 - This is not an indictment against Physicians, it shows that man could not help (Mark 10:27)
 - She grabbed a vision of healing, and she said repeatedly, "If only I may touch His cloths, I shall be made well." See the Lord's vision and declare the outcome Proverbs 18:21, Mark 11:20-24, Job 22:28, 2 Corinthians 4:13
 - Jesus did not become unclean when she touched him, she became clean, The tassel at the hem of the garment reminded Israel of their healing covenant – Mark 6:56, Numbers 15:38-39, Exodus 15:26
 - She was made well, or whole. "Sozo" healed, saved, delivered
 - Faith has an object. You do not have faith in your faith, you have faith in God. It is not your power to believe, it is your trust in an all-powerful God.
- 4) Jesus demonstrates his power over death vs.35-43
 - A report of death was countered with a word to believe vs.36
 - Jesus showed His power over nature (Mark 4:39), demons (Mark 5:15), sickness and now death itself.

Touching the tassel is a prophetic object lesson. Communion and Baptism are object lessons that reveal deep truths about your salvation and carry spiritual blessings
